Cardboard, cooking oil and cork pick-up is only available on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Oyster shell recycling is available six days a week.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE?

- Place your recyclable material on the street by 6 a.m.
- You can put your material out the night before.
- Make sure you break down your cardboard.
- No waxed cardboard allowed.
- Place your cooking oil on top of a piece of cardboard.

PICK-UP ROUTE AVAILABLE: Beginning at King and Line Street. Includes King Street to Market Street. From North Market and South Market, then right on Meeting Street and right on Hayne Street. Return to Meeting Street (by way of Pinckney & Hasell Streets).
